Ordering & Delivery

How our nursery works: We grow most of our trees in the open ground and they are lifted, graded and dispatched when the trees are dormant during the winter months from early June to late August. Some species are grown in plugs or pots, which does allow for an extended planting season from Autumn through to Spring.

Trees are tied in bundles of 10 and packed into plastic bags with moss around their bare roots to keep them moist in transit until planting. These bags are encased in double walled paper outer bags and strapped for transport with Aramex couriers. Container grown species are packed into cartons.

Larger orders will be dispatched either in wooden bins or bags and or cartons strapped onto a pallet with Mainfreight. We will always pack & choose which freight company to minimize the freights costs to our customers.

Collection from the nursery can also be arranged with a minimum of 3 days notice.



Freight charges - what's the cost? Our preferred courier provider is Aramex. They provide a *two day service* to the North Island and *overnight* within the South Island.
